



Sino-EU PerMed Delegation Visit to Munich and Milano

In April 2023 a delegation will visit renowned European institutions in the sphere of personalised medicine. The visit is organized by the EU-funded Project Sino-EU PerMed. Part of the project is to support the personal exchange of Chinese and European researchers by organizing delegation visits. The scope of the delegation visit is to increase the dialogue between key stakeholders in Europe and China. The delegation trip will take place in Munich and Milan from April 16th until April 22nd. The delegation consists of scientists and consortium members, including ten experts from China. The trip will take the delegation to the two important metropolitan areas of Munich (Germany) and Milan (Italy).

The following institutions will be visited in Munich: Helmholtz Center for Health and Environment; TranslaTUM and BioM. On the 18th of April the 3rd Sino-EU PerMed Science & Technology Workshop will take place as a hybrid event at BioM. After visiting Munich, the delegation will be heading off to Milan.

The following institutions will be visited in Milan: Human Technopole; San Raffaele Telethon-Institute for Gene Therapy, Center for Omics Sciences, Functional Genomics of Cancer Unit; National Institute of Molecular Genetics and the National Cancer Institute.
