

3rd Sino-EU Permed webinar on personalised medicine perspectives in cancer and its links with Traditional Chinese Medicine

The recent science and technology webinar organised under the Sino-EU PerMed project was the third workshop of its kind. Held on 18 April as a hybrid event during the Clover Leaf delegation tour in Munich and Milan, the workshop brought together 22 participants onsite and an additional 42 participants online. The event was kindly hosted by the BioM biotech cluster in Munich.

The webinar presented examples from key areas related to personalised medicine perspectives in cancer and its links with Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM), covering a wide range of topics including basic research, databases, genomics/proteomics, biomarkers, diagnostics, clinical translation into healthcare and industrial perspectives. Each topic was presented by both Chinese and European scientists, with a total of two European and five Chinese scientists sharing their valuable insights and research findings.

The science and technology webinars organised by the Sino-EU PerMed project aim to promote collaboration, cooperation and networking activities between China and the EU. By facilitating the exchange of expertise and knowledge in personalised medicine, the project plays a key role in advancing the global landscape of this rapidly developing field.
