



## **2nd Sino-EU PerMed Science & Technology Webinar on Perspectives in Personalised Medicine: developments in cancer research**

On 13th December the Sino-EU PerMed Project held its second webinar on Science and Technology in Personalised Medicine in Europe and China.

In total six Chinese and four European scientists presented their recent work on cancer research:

Han Dali (Beijing Institute of Genomics, CAS), Xu Yong (Guangzhou Institutes of Biomedicine and Health CAS), Leming Shi (School of Life Sciences, Fudan University), Huan Meng (National Center for Nanoscience and Technology, Beijing), Zhirong Shen (BeiGene) and Qing Xu (Simcere Pharmaceutical, Nanjing)

Michele Maio (University of Siena), Manfred Dietel (Charité University Hospital, Berlin), Clare Turnbull (Institute of Cancer Research, Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust, London) and Frederik Klauschen (Institutes of Pathology, Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, Munich)

It was shown that the field of personalised medicine in cancer research is very broad and already highly developed. From RNA modification over protein degradation to multi-omics approaches the presenters showed a wide variation of approaches for cancer diagnostics and treatment.

More than 92 participants from China, Italy, Germany, Belgium, Denmark, Poland, Portugal and Spain registered to the event.
